Cutting Instructions:

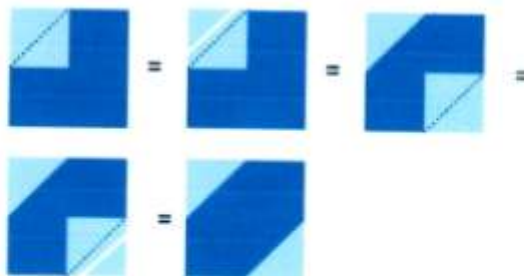
Fabric:	Size & Shape:	# to Cut:
A (Dark Blue)	4-1/2" Square	3
A (Dark Blue)	2-1/2" Square	6
A (Dark Blue)	2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Rectangle	4
B <i>white or white</i>	2-1/2" Square	4
B <i>white or white</i>	2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Rectangle	4
B <i>white or white</i>	4-1/2" Square	2

Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Using a pencil and a ruler, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all Color A (dk blue) 2-1/2" squares, and all Color B (*w-w*) 2-1/2" squares.

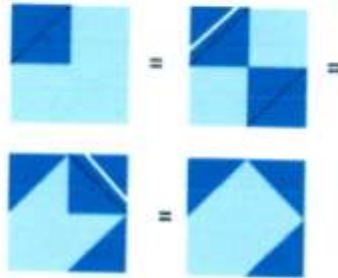


Step 2: Place a Color B (*w-w*) 2-1/2" square in the upper left corner of a Color A (dark blue) 4-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal line that you drew in Step 1. Trim away the fabric 1/4" above the seam and press the seam allowance toward the Color B (*w-w*) fabric. Trim points. Repeat in the lower right corner, as shown below. Make 2. (This unit should measure 4-1/2" square.)



Sew, trim, and press. Make 2.

Step 3: Place a Color A (dk blue) $2\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ square in the upper left corner of a Color B ($\omega\text{-}\omega$) $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ square, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal line that you drew in Step 1. Trim away the fabric $1/4\text{'}$ above the seam and press the seam allowance toward the Color A (dk blue) fabric. Trim points. Repeat in two more corners, as shown below. Make 2. (This unit should measure $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ square.)



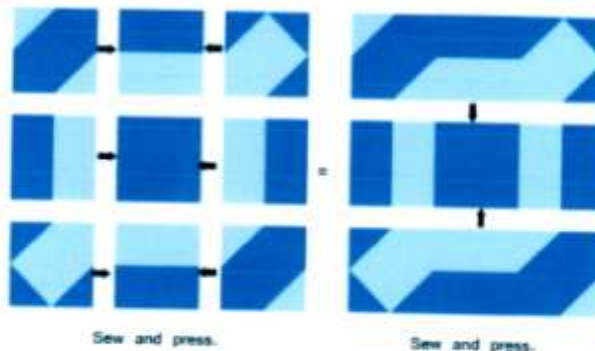
Sew, trim, and press. Make 2.

Step 4: Sew a Color A (dk blue) $2\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ x $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ rectangle to a Color B ($\omega\text{-}\omega$) $2\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ x $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ rectangle, as shown below. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Make 4. (This unit should measure $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ x $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$)



Sew and press. Make 4

Step 5: Arrange the Step 2 units, the Step 3 units, the Step 4 units, and the Color A (dk blue) $4\text{-}1/2\text{'}$ square as shown below. Sew into rows and press the seam allowances toward the Step 4 units. Next, sew the rows together to finish the block. Press the seam allowances toward the center row.

Your block should measure 12-1/2" at this point. It will measure 12" when it is sewn into a quilt.
